

A GUIDE TO USE CLASSES

The following is a guide to the Use Classes Order 1987 describing the uses allowed under the various classes and the permitted changes of use allowed under the General Development Order 1988.

Class and description

A1 General retail shops including retail warehouses, hairdressers, travel agents, dry cleaners, pet shops

A2 Shops used for financial and professional services including banks, building societies, estate agents, employment agents, betting offices.

A3 Restaurant

for consumption of food and drink on the premises.

A4 Public House or wine bar

A5 Take away restaurant

Sui generis

There are certain uses of shops which are not within the above classes and therefore require specific planning consent:

- Motor vehicle showrooms

- Launderettes, taxi or vehicle hire, amusement centres

B1 (a) offices

(b) research and development, studios, laboratories

(c) light industrial

B2 General industrial

B8 Storage or distribution

C1 Hotel boarding and guest houses

C2 Residential schools and colleges

C3 Residential dwellings

D1 Church halls, clinics, health centres, day nurseries, creches

D2 Cinemas, music and concert halls, dance and sport halls, Yoga/pilates studios and gyms
